FLOWER CATEGORY

1. Each exhibitor is limited to 1 entry per class.
2. Entries in flower classes are open to amateurs' only and only one adult exhibitor from any one address.
3. An amateur is defined as one who makes less than 20% of their income from plants and flowers.
4. Containers for Arrangement classes must be marked on the bottom of the container with the exhibitor's name and address. **Do not use a valuable container.**
5. Fair personnel can remove wilted or unsightly exhibits at any time.
6. No extra foliage is allowed in any horticultural class.
7. The decision of the judges will be final.

- K1 Soo Big! – Largest fresh homegrown Dahlia. Can use fair container to display.
- K2 School Days – A dish garden of a variety of green plants or succulents for the principals desk. Accessories can be used.
- K3 Welcome Fall – A patio container using fall garden plants.
- K4 Mums the Word – A potted mum with festive accessories in a decorative container.
- K5 Garden Gladiolus - Arrangement of Gladiolus in your own container

- K6 Pumpkin Patch – A fall fresh and dried flower arrangement using a pumpkin and/or gourds.
- K7 Dahlia Delight – A fresh arrangement using homegrown Dahlia's.
- K8 Veterans Honor – A patriotic silk arrangement honor America Veterans.
- K9 Autumn Corn – A door decoration using Indian Corn. Accessories can be used.
- K10 Your Favorite Holiday – A silk and/or dried arrangement for your favorite holiday table.
- K11 Harvest Time at the State Fair – A festive display of pumpkins, gourds, flowers, plants, vegetables, fruits, nuts, wine, honey, etc. Not fewer than 3 different types of categories included. **Maximum size of container is 15"L x 10"W x 4"H.**
- K12 Recycle It - A fresh arrangement in a recycled container.
- K13 Marigolds and Zinnias - A fresh arrangement of marigolds and zinnias from your garden in a canning jar.
- K14 Summer Hydrangea - An arrangement of hydrangeas from your garden.
- K15 Grandparent's Day - Honor your grandparents with a festive fall silk and/or dried arrangement.

VEGETABLE CATEGORY

1. Each exhibitor is limited to 1 entry per class. Quantities specified in the exhibit list will be strictly adhered to.
2. All exhibits are to be grown by exhibitor, except the Decorated Pumpkin Classes. See Decorated Pumpkin specific criteria below.
3. Quantities specified in the exhibit list will be strictly adhered to.
4. Include variety, if known, on tag when entering exhibit.
5. The Fair is not responsible for lost or damaged items.
6. The decision of the judges will be final.

Basis for Judging

Exhibits will be judged on the basis of quality, condition, uniformity and trueness to variety. In order to rate highest in quality the product must be in the best edible stage. It should be free from blemishes caused by disease, insects, or other factors. The term "uniformity" applies to size, shape and color as representative of the variety. The average size from the commercial standpoint, rather than the largest specimens, should be exhibited.

- K16 Lima Beans, in pod (1 quart)
- K17 Gourds, 1 variety (5)
- K18 Gourds, mixed (5)
- K19 Gourds, Display-maximum number of Gourds in display - 10
Maximum size of container is 15"L x 10"W x 4"H
- K20 Peppers, Bell types, any color (4)
- K21 Peppers, any sweet (5)
- K22 Peppers, any hot type (5)
- K23 Peppers, Display-not fewer than 3 varieties (3 each)
Maximum size of container is 15"L x 10"W x 4"H
- K24 Potatoes, sweet potato, any variety, identify variety (5)

- K25 *Pumpkin, Decorated, Youth up to Age 12
- K26 *Pumpkin, Decorated, Over Age 13
- K27 Pumpkin, Miniature, any variety (5)
- K28 Tomatoes, heaviest, **green**, any variety (1)
- K29 Tomatoes, Display-not fewer than 3 varieties (3 each)
Maximum size of container is 15"L x 10"W x 4"H
- K30 Root Vegetables, Display, 3 different root vegetables
(Root Vegetables can include – Carrots, Garlic, Kohlrabi, Onions, Parsnips, Potatoes, Sweet Potatoes, Turnips). **Displayed on Fair provided plate.**

*Classes K25 and K26 Pumpkin, Decorated Criteria: Pumpkins can be homegrown/purchased, no artificial pumpkins. Pumpkins must not be carved or hollowed out. No electrical device may be used and no stencils or kits permitted. Materials of any kind may be pinned and/or glued to the pumpkin. Painting or drawing on the pumpkin is allowed. Judging criteria will include originality, creativity, workmanship, overall appearance.
