ALSA Sanctioned Show – Saturday, September 9th, 2023 – 9AM

SPECIAL RULES

1. ALSA membership is not a requirement to show. Exhibitors pay \$5/animal (included in entry fee) to ALSA. Non-ALSA youth pay a \$15 non-member fee per show, due at check-in. Upon request, members must present ALSA membership card to Show Management to verify membership.
2. Entry must be made in the exact names (owner and animal) as shown on the registration certificate. Equity investment on ARI or AOA registration certificates will be considered as full ownership for the equity owner entering an alpaca. Youth are not required to own the animal they show in youth performance.
3. Ages are as of January 1, except for eight-year-olds, who are eligible to show as of their birthday. Juniors are ages 7 to 11, Intermediates are ages 12 to 14 years and Seniors are ages 15 to 19 years. If an individual turn 19 during their final youth show season, they have the option to show in the Senior Showmanship. **For more information on Showmanship Rules & Regulations, please refer to the [ALSA Handbook](#) found on their website (Section L. – Page 73).**
4. Youth must have written permission of a parent, project leader, 4-H advisor or FFA advisor to participate in a Youth event.
5. Youth may exhibit only one entry per Youth class.
6. All entries must be in the name of the Youth.
7. Llamas and Alpacas must belong to or be leased/loaned to the Youth, their family, the project group, etc.
8. Animals will not accumulate Awards in the Youth division. The Youth accumulate the Awards.
9. The same animal shall NOT be entered in two different performance divisions. Entries in performance classes are restricted in that an animal may be entered in a youth class or a non-youth class (Open, Advanced, Master or Novice classes), but not both. **Please familiarize yourself with all Youth Performance Rules & Regulations found in the [ALSA Handbook](#) (Section M. – Page 76).**
10. Use of a Llama/Alpaca by more than one youth is strongly discouraged. If deemed a necessity by the Show Superintendent, it may be allowed as long as the animal is shared by no more than two youth.
11. Only voice and hand commands may be used in exhibiting animals. The use of food, clicker or any other device is strictly prohibited.
12. Superintendents may, at their discretion, break or combine classes.
