#### Table II, Sec. 1 - Time First Round

The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses/Ponies with clean rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

#### Table II, Sec. 2.b - Time First Jump Off

The first round and first jump off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed, if any. If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, he/she will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump-off course. In the event of equality of faults after the first round, there will be one jump-off for first place only in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults.
