# F. GROVE MILLER SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE JUNE 1, 2025

The Maryland State Fair will sponsor four (4) \$2,000 scholarships in honor of F. Grove Miller to Maryland youth who are enrolled in a four-year college, post-secondary college, or trade school.

Recipients will be selected based on participation in the Maryland State Fair, academic performance, leadership qualities, future goals, and financial need.

#### Qualifications

- 1. This scholarship is available to all permanent residents of the State of Maryland who participated in the 2024 and previous years of the Maryland State Fair.
- Students must be pursuing a four-year degree at the college of their choice, enrolled in a postsecondary college, or enrolled in a trade school. Students must provide proof of enrollment to the Maryland State Fair Office by August 1st of the academic year in which the scholarship is awarded.
- 3. This scholarship is available to students entering their freshman through senior year of college.
- 4. The scholarships will be awarded during the Maryland 4-H/FFA Judging Awards Program at the Maryland State Fair.
- 5. Students may apply for the F. Grove Miller State Fair Scholarship and the Marlin K. Hoff Scholarship. However, students are only eligible to win only one scholarship in the same year.
- 6. Students are eligible to win a maximum of two Maryland State Fair sponsored scholarships.
- 7. The scholarship is for one year only.
