Division Rules & Regulations: The fitting and preparation of all animals for exhibit is the responsibility of the Exhibitor. Exhibitors may receive guidance only from immediate family members, Maryland 4-H/FFA Members and appointed MCE Volunteers/FFA Advisors.

- Exhibitors and their exhibits must comply with the "General State Fair Rules & Regulations", "General 4-H and FFA Rules & Regulations", "Animal Rules & Regulations", the "Maryland 4-H Code of Animal Science Ethics", the "Health Regulations for Livestock Exhibited in Maryland", these "Division Rules & Regulations" and the applicable "Section Rules & Regulations".
- Entries:** Entries will be received beginning at 12 pm (noon) on Wednesday, August 20th in the Cow Palace. All animals must be in place by 12 pm (noon) on Thursday, August 21st. Exhibitors must remain in the stalls assigned to them by the Superintendent. Please do not bring tack/décor or animals before Wednesday, August 20th. Refer to "Schedule of Events" and "4-H/FFA Exhibit Entry Information" for additional information.

Pre-entry is required. **YOU MUST USE THE INTERNET ENTRY SYSTEMS FOUND AT www.marylandstatefair.com** Internet entries are due **July 15th**. Exhibitors without internet access should contact their County Extension Educator for assistance. All release forms are to be completed online through the entry system at time of registration. Reminder you must have completed the Animal Husbandry & Quality Assurance program to be able to exhibit your animals. Check with your county to make sure you are up to date with this requirement.

- **NEW RULE** Ownership:** All Feeder Dairy Steer animals exhibited must be owned, registered and tagged and weighed with a Maryland 4-H/FFA Tag in the Exhibitor's name only by June 1st of the current year and be under one year of age. All Market Dairy Steers must be owned by January 1st. **ALL MARKET DAIRY STEERS MUST BE UNDER 2 YEARS OF AGE FROM THE DATE OF THE SHOW. (TO SHOW IN 2025 – MUST BE BORN AFTER AUGUST 22, 2023).**
- Steers will be weighed and must be tagged with a MD 4-H/FFA Livestock Tag. Weighing is at 3:30pm, Thursday, August 21st at the Cow Palace Scales. Superintendents may at their discretion, break or combine classes.
- The Dairy Steer Show** will be held Friday, August 22nd at 6:00pm.
- Herdsmanship:** Special recognition will be given to the counties maintaining the most attractive and neatest pens and aisles. The total number of counties will be divided into two groups and an award presented to each group. The Herdsmanship contest will be combined with the Dairy department contest.
- The Grand Champion Dairy Steer must be sold through the Livestock Sale. In order to sell your animal at the Youth Livestock Sale, it must make a Daily Rate of Gain of 1.8 pounds in addition to meeting the 1,100-lb minimum weight. Please see Youth Livestock Sale Rules found in 4-H/FFA Division X, Section XIV for additional information. Exhibitors are limited to a maximum of ONE species in the Youth Livestock Sale.
- BEDDING:** The Maryland State Fair will provide a base-layer of tan-bark for dairy steer stalls.
