Division Rules & Regulations:

ELIGIBILITY – Exhibitors

- Only 4-H and FFA members may exhibit in this division. Exhibitors and their exhibits must comply with the "General State Fair Rules & Regulations", "General 4-H and FFA Rules & Regulations", "Animal Rules & Regulations", the "Maryland 4-H Code of Animal Science Ethics", the "Health Regulations for Livestock Exhibited in Maryland", these "Division Rules & Regulations" and the applicable "Section Rules & Regulations". The *Maryland 4-H Horse and Pony Show Rule Book* (2023 edition) will be used. The *Maryland 4-H Horse and Pony Show Rule Book* is available at the Maryland 4-H website at <https://extension.umd.edu/programs/4-h-youth-development/program-areas/animal-sciences/4-h-horse-program>. Class descriptions and restrictions are in the Maryland 4-H Horse and Pony Show Rule Book.
- Pre-entry is required. **YOU MUST USE THE INTERNET ENTRY SYSTEMS FOUND AT www.marylandstatefair.com** Internet entries are due July 15th. Exhibitors without internet access should contact their County Extension Educator for assistance. All release will be completed once you sign onto the Internet Entry System and emailed to the Maryland State Fair immediately.
- Eligibility for the Maryland State Fair Horse and Pony Show will be verified by the 4-H Extension Educator for 4-H Exhibitors and FFA Advisors for FFA Exhibitors.
- Performance requirements for showing are outlined in the *Maryland 4-H Horse and Pony Show Rule Book* (2023 edition). **Members must have completed the appropriate Tiers of the Maryland 4-H Equine Showmanship and Equitation Standards program.** See the Maryland 4-H Horse Program webpage at <https://extension.umd.edu/programs/4-h-youth-development/program-areas/animal-sciences/4-h-horse-program>.
- FFA exhibitors must have the same performance requirements as 4-Hers or the equivalent and must have shown in at least one horse show. Please contact the FFA Advisor for further information about FFA qualifications. Horse Show superintendent must receive copies of completed requirements for FFA members.

ELIGIBILITY – Horses

- Proof of a negative Coggins test within the past 12 months and a completed MDA Equine Exhibitor's Self-Certification of Equine Health Form must be presented at time of check in. This form is available at the Maryland Department of Agriculture web site and may be required to enter the fairgrounds.
- All exhibitors must have a Horse and Pony Card (including formal lease agreement if not owned) filed with the county Extension office by June 1 of the current year for each animal.
- In classes restricted to ponies, animals may not be shown in any class identified as a Pony class unless the exhibitor possesses a measurement card issued by the United States Equestrian Federation (formerly AHSA, USEA) or an affiliated association (MHSA) or other recognized horse show association or the Maryland 4-H Program. Every pony must be measured each year until it reaches the age of 6 years (Maryland 4-H Horse & Pony Show Rule book). A Steward will be present at our shows, at a time to be announced, to measure those ponies needing a card. All animals without a measurement card will be eligible for horse classes only.
- Height divisions for ponies will be: English-Small Ponies - 12.2 hands and under; Medium Ponies - over 12.2 hands and not exceeding 13.2 hands; Large Ponies - over 13.2 hands and not exceeding 14.2 hands; Horses - over 14.2 hands; Western Ponies - under 14.1 hands; Horses - 14.1 hands and over.

SAFETY

- Exhibitors must wear suitable shoes or boots at all times while in the barn and show ring areas, both mounted and on the ground - NO EXCEPTIONS. Trainers, coaches, leaders and parents in the schooling and barn areas must also wear suitable shoes or boots at all times. Suitable shoes must be closed toe and heel shoes that zip or lace or cover the ankle. Anyone mounted must wear boots with appropriate heels.
- Both English and Western riders must wear certified ASTM/SEI headgear at all times while mounted and lunging. Harnesses must be secured and properly fitted. Headgear must carry ASTM and SEI seals.
- Exhibitors are required to follow stable management guidelines. Failure to comply or cooperate with management could result in forfeiture of premiums and/or future participation privileges.
- Horses and ponies may only be ridden by the Exhibitor unless expressly permitted by Show Management. Animals may not be ridden outside the general stable and show ring areas.
- All exhibitors MUST report for a tack and equipment check prior to their first mounted class and before any additional class if a tack change is made (Example: Speed).**

SHOW RULES

- Entries for this division must be available and ready for check-in at least one-half hour before the posted start time for the class being entered. Due to limited stable space, animals will be released at the end of the show and are not allowed to remain in the stalls for more than 2 hours after their last class of the day without permission from the Stable Manager or Superintendent.

- Entries for each show are received according to the following schedule:

Junior + Intermediate English Classes	Friday, August 22, 7:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.
Senior English Classes	Saturday, August 23, 7:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.
- Classes may be combined or divided at the discretion of Show Management.

19. Exhibitors approved to participate will be limited to a total of four (4) animals for all classes for 2 days of showing. Up to four (4) animals may be exhibited in Conformation classes. **Each Exhibitor may exhibit one animal in Showmanship per day.** Up to two (2) animals may be exhibited in Performance classes with the following restrictions:
 - a. Exhibitors may show two (2) animals in any combination of divisions of Performance classes except as noted below.
 - b. An Exhibitor MAY CROSS ENTER the same horse between Western and English shows, but NOT between Hunter and Pleasure divisions.
 - c. An Exhibitor may only enter one Equitation Division per day.
 - d. If a horse is shared by a Junior and an Intermediate on English day, one exhibitor may show in the Hunter Division and the other in the Pleasure division.
 - e. If a horse is shared by a Junior and an Intermediate on Western day, a horse may be shown in each speed class only once.
 - f. Exhibitors must follow all rules concerning arrival and departure of horses. Stalls will be assigned for horses for each show without consideration of entries for other days.
 - g. Exhibitors showing in two shows will be limited to a TOTAL of 4 horses including performance, conformation, and showmanship classes.
 - h. A horse may be entered in only ONE conformation class and ONE showmanship class per day.
20. Exhibitors will be allowed to cross enter their horses between English and Western shows. If a horse is leased by two (2) Exhibitors, each Exhibitor may cross enter between English and Western shows not to exceed a total class limit of 12 total performance classes per horse/rider combo **for both shows combined.** NO HORSE MAY BE SHOWN IN MORE THAN 24 PERFORMANCE CLASSES OVER THE TOTAL 4 SHOWS OFFERED.
21. Grooming and showmanship regulations and attire will be as outlined in the Maryland 4-H Horse and Pony Show Rule Book. Grooming and Showmanship will be judged as follows: Grooming (25), Showmanship (50), Knowledge (15), and Personal Appearance (10). Grooming will be done outside the ring by the exhibitor prior to the start of the class.
22. Speed Classes begin when the exhibitor enters the ring and ends upon leaving the ring.
23. Assistance/coaching from outside the ring is not permitted. **Exhibitors receiving coaching from outside the ring will have only one warning before disqualification. Coaches receiving more than 2) warnings will be asked to leave the arena.**
24. Awards
 - a. Rosettes will be awarded to the top 10 placings in each class. Champions and Reserve Champions will receive rosettes and awards.
 - b. The Hank Shirley Memorial Equitation Award will be presented to the High Point Winners in Senior Equitation for all 3 Senior divisions.
25. **A bedding fee will be charged at the time of entry to cover the initial bedding (straw) that will be supplied by the Fair. Additional bedding (straw) is the responsibility of the exhibitor. A limited amount of Straw will also be available for purchase on the grounds. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning their stalls; Exhibitors not cleaning their stalls will forfeit all premiums.**
