RULES AND REGULATIONS

ONLY ONE ENTRY PER PERSON, PER CLASS ALLOWED

1. **Please read the General Rules for the Home Arts Department, which apply, to all Sections.**
2. Each exhibitor may only enter one division: professional, amateur or youth/children. A professional is defined as one who teaches art, who belongs to any professional arts organization, or who regularly earns more than \$1000.00 per year in the arts. An amateur is one who paints for pleasure. Youth are defined as any exhibitor 12-17 years of age on August 1. Children are defined as any exhibitor under 12 years of age on August 1.
3. **ONLY FIVE WORKS PER PERSON WILL BE ACCEPTED. NO REPRODUCED WORK WILL BE ACCEPTED**
4. The name and address of Exhibitor must be on reverse of each piece entered. Exhibitors are encouraged to use stick-on address labels.
5. **Works must be within two years of age.**
6. The maximum size for all work except for special contests G32, G42 & G43 and classes G37 to G39 is 26" in any direction including mat and frame.
7. Except for Special Contests and Children, all work G1 - G36 must be properly framed with braided picture wire securely fastened with screw eyes to the back of the frame. All work other than oils and acrylics treated like oils must be matted and framed under glass. Scotch tape, Velcro, duct tape, monofilament wire, staples, or hot glue will not be acceptable for use in framing. Clip frames are not acceptable. Metal frames must have secure slots, which allow wire attachment, or be drilled with wire already inserted. Wire and eyes are no longer supplied.
8. Acrylics should be entered as watercolor or oil – not in "other media" classes. Acrylics painted with water on paper must be entered as a watercolor, matted and framed under glass. Acrylics painted on canvas must be entered as an oil painting
9. All exhibits in "other media/mixed media/digital art", must include a description of the media used. Digital art must include a description of the program/software and process used to produce the exhibit. Classes G7, 11, 14, 17, 20, 23, 26, 30, 35, and 39
10. Oil paintings **MUST** be dry. Wet paintings will not be accepted.
11. **BASIS FOR JUDGING: Composition, use of color, technical skill, creativity, originality, overall presentation, including matting and framing.**

CHILDREN UNDER 12 YEARS OLD

Open to children who have not reached their 12th Birthday by August 1, 2024. Work should reflect the age and level of ability of the child. Child's age should be noted on entry tag. Exhibitors are to submit work matted and covered with clear plastic. Framed work will not be accepted. Maximum size, including mat 12" x 16".
