

# **F. GROVE MILLER SCHOLARSHIP & KINSLEY SCHOLARSHIP**

## **DEADLINE JUNE 1, 2026**

The Maryland State Fair will sponsor \$2,000 scholarships in memory of F. Grove Miller to Maryland youth who are enrolled in a four-year college, postsecondary institution, or trade school.

The Kinsley Scholarship (\$2,000) supports Maryland youth currently pursuing a postsecondary degree in pre-veterinary medicine or large animal veterinary medicine.

Recipients will be selected based on participation in the Maryland State Fair, academic achievement, leadership qualities, future goals, and demonstrated financial need.

### **Qualifications**

1. This scholarship is available to all permanent residents of the State of Maryland who participated in the 2025 and/or previous years of the Maryland State Fair.
2. Students must be pursuing a four-year degree at the college of their choice, enrolled in a postsecondary college, or enrolled in a trade school. Students must provide proof of enrollment to the Maryland State Fair Office by August 1st of the academic year in which the scholarship is awarded.
3. This scholarship is available to students entering their freshman through senior year of college.
4. The F. Grove Miller Maryland State Fair Scholarships and the Kinsley Scholarship will be awarded during the Maryland 4-H/FFA Judging Awards Program at the Maryland State Fair, Saturday, September 5th, 2026 at 6PM in the Cow Palace.
5. Students may apply for the F. Grove Miller Maryland State Fair Scholarship, Marlin K. Hoff Scholarship, and the Kinsley Scholarship. However, students are only eligible to win one scholarship in the same year.
6. Students are eligible to win a maximum of two Maryland State Fair sponsored scholarships.
7. The scholarship is for one year only.
