SPECIAL RULES

1. After online entry, you will receive via mail an exhibitor letter and an attachment (**show entry form**) with instructions that must be returned to the Superintendent prior to the show. **You must submit the entry form no later than 9:00 pm on Wednesday, September 9, 2026** via email to donnajrichards@hotmail.com.
2. All rabbit exhibitors must fill out a Self Certification of Rabbit Health prior to loading animals at home and shall be presented to the designated fair and show representative upon arrival at the show. The required form may be found on the Maryland Department of Agriculture website at <https://mda.maryland.gov/AnimalHealth/Pages/Fairs-Shows.aspx>
3. **The OPEN Rabbit Show will begin at 9:00 am OPEN will follow Youth on each judge's table. Youth Meat Pens judged first. This will be a carrier show with animals being released at the end of the show or as allowed by the Superintendent.**
4. Ear number substitutions will be allowed in same breed, variety, age and sex on the day of the show. No substitutions will be allowed for a different breed. **Rabbits must be permanently tattooed in left ear.**
5. **The fitting and preparation of all animals for exhibit is the responsibility of the Exhibitor.**
6. All exhibits must be a breed recognized by ARBA. Mixed breeds are not allowed. The book, "Standard of Perfection" outlines the standards for each recognized breed. It can be ordered online at www.arba.net or by calling (814) 297-8233. Exhibitors are responsible for obtaining a Rabbit Breeds and Varieties List to assist in properly filling out the entry form.
7. Any exhibit displaying signs of disease or in poor fleshing condition will be refused entry. The decision of the Superintendent is final.
8. With the exception of meat pens, rabbits under 3 months old or over 2 weeks pregnant will not be allowed. Meat pens should be at least 8 weeks old and not over 10 weeks of age.
9. **Ownership:** All rabbits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor by August 1st of the current year.
10. **Judging:** This is an official American Rabbit Breeders Association (ARBA) sanctioned show.
11. Only rabbits entered in the show may be brought onto the fairgrounds.
12. The ARBA National Convention will be held October 24-28, 2026 in Reno, NV ([2026 ARBA Convention](#)). ARBA Contact: Eric Stewart, Executive Director, PO Box 400, Knox, PA 16232-0400 Phone (814) 297-8233. ARBA Website: <https://arba.net/>
13. Following the Youth Market Pen judging, all ARBA recognized breeds will be judged in an order decided on by the show superintendent based on the number in each breed and will be posted at the judging table prior to the start of the show.
14. **Awards:** Premiums and ribbons will be awarded to the 1st – 10th Place exhibits in each breed. Rosettes will be awarded for Best/Best Opposite of Breed, Best/Best Opposite Varieties and Best/Best Opposite Groups in all breed classes.
15. **Judges' decisions are final. Harassment of judges or show officials will not be tolerated.**
16. If you would like to sponsor the cost of a breed sanction, you must contact the show secretary no later than August 1, 2026.
17. You will be issued a parking permit and admission pass (1 per exhibitor) when you arrive and check-in.
18. Entry Fees are \$5.00 per animal.
19. The Youth Show and the Open Show are sanctioned separately, youth may enter both shows.
20. Rabbits will be accepted at the SOUTH END of the COW PALACE according to the following schedule:

Arrival on **Saturday, September 12th at 7:30 AM**
Judging will take place **Saturday, September 12th, 2026 at 9:00 AM**
Rabbits will be released on **Saturday, September 12th following the show** (at Superintendents discretion).
